In 2024, we will be expanding our service offering through Dr. Dayal's incorporation of therapies to enhance the quality of patients' sleep. We will also be expanding the total number of hours available for patient care and emphasizing same day treatment. We will continue to evaluate a range of new dental products that offer more sustainable attributes. Developing leadership and presentation skills will be a focus for our team this year. Our team will have two different health insurance plan designs with two different insurance carriers, now our employees have more options. We will be working with Henry Shein to support their evaluation of new sustainable products entering the consumable dental products marketplace. Our community and environmental contribution plans include collaborations with Henry Shein to offer a complimentary webinar on how organizations within the dental industry can better manage their carbon footprint and move to become carbon neutral. Artisan Dental will also be collaborating with FDI World Dental Federations, Sustainability in Dentistry Task Force to develop a presentation for the World Dental Congress around carbon neutral practices. A similar presentation will also be offered at the annual Sustainability in Dentistry virtual summit. Lastly, Artisan Dental's example around how to become a carbon neutral practice will be featured as a case study on the FDI World Dental Federations website.


