Microlaryngoscopy Patient Pre-operative and Post-operative Instructions

Medications to stop two weeks prior to surgery:

- Aspirin
- Plavix
- Ibuprofen (Motrin, Advil)
- Naprosyn (Alleve)
- Vitamin E
- Gingko Biloba
- Fish Oil

Medications to stop four days prior to surgery:

• Warfarin (Coumadin)

Please consult your Primary Physician or Cardiologist prior to stopping your anticoagulants. May resume medications one week following surgery.

DAY BEFORE SURGERY - **NOTHING BY MOUTH AFTER MIDNIGHT**

Medications to take the morning of surgery (unless otherwise instructed by your PCP):

- Antihypertensive (blood pressure)
- Anti-reflux (Nexium, Aciphex, Omeprazole, Protonix, Zegerid, Prevacid, Kapidex, Zantac, Pencid
- Antibiotics for heart or metal implants will be given IV prior to surgery

Medications NOT to take the morning of surgery (unless otherwise instructed by your PCP):

Glucose lowering medications, including insulin

Restrictions:

- Absolute voice rest for seven (7) days
- · Graduated return to voicing:
 - o Day 8 (may speak for 10 minutes)
 - o Day 9 (may speak for 20 minutes)
 - o Day 10 (may speak for 40 minutes)
 - o Day 11 (may speak for 80 minutes)
 - o Day 12 (may speak for 160 minutes)
 - Day 14 (may return to normal vocal activities
- No diet or other physical activity restrictions
