Before Your Procedure at the Museo ASC

- Once you are scheduled for your procedure at the Museo ASC, a team member will contact you about your insurance and coverage.
- A nurse from the surgery center will call you 1-3 business days before your appointment to discuss pre-operative instructions and answer any questions you may have.
- Your physician will order laboratory tests for you prior to the procedure.
- If you are having moderate sedation: You should not drink or eat solid food 6 hours before your procedure. Please follow your physician's instructions about the medications to take the morning of your procedure.
- If you have an Advanced Directive or Medical Power of Attorney, please bring a copy to the center on the day of your procedure. You may complete these documents at: <https://www.hhs.texas.gov/formas/advance-directives>
- An adult over the age of 18 must drive you home after your procedure.

For your health and safety, please check with your physician before & after your procedure to determine which medication(s) to continue or discontinue.

What to Bring the Day Of Your Procedure

- List of current medications, including all herbal and over-the-counter medications
- Driver's License or other form of state or federal ID
- Insurance card(s)
- Cashier's check or credit card for any co-pay or deductible that is owed
- Comfortable, loose-fitting clothes; if having a pacemaker or defibrillator implanted, please wear a button-up shirt
- Advanced Directive or Medical Power of Attorney
- We recommend any visitor accompanying you bring a light jacket while they wait for you
- DO NOT bring anything of value to the center. A locker will be provided for your personal belongings
- For implant patients, please bring your smart phone to set up the device monitoring application

During Your Procedure

- The room will be cool; warm blankets are available at your request
- You will be connected to monitoring equipment, such as the blood pressure cuff, heart monitor, and pulse oximetry
- A nurse will remain with you during your procedure to ensure your safety and comfort.
- Your friends and family will be in the Museo ASC waiting room. The physician will speak to them after the procedure.

After Your Procedure

- You will be taken to the recovery room, where a nurse will care for you.
- Your physician will determine the length of time for your bed rest.
- Your vital signs will be monitored during your recovery.
- Pain Management is essential to us. Please tell your nurse at any time if you are uncomfortable.
- While in recovery, the nurse will provide you with a light snack and beverage.
- You and a responsible adult will receive verbal and written discharge information. We recommend he/she stay with you for 24 hours following the procedure.
- The Museo ASC nursing staff will call you the next day to follow up on your recovery.

Directions to the Museo ASC



From 69/59 N:

- Exit 128A to Fannin St.
- Left on Southmore Blvd.
- Left on San Jacinto St.
- Parking Garage entrance is on the left off of San Jacinto.
- Parking is available on levels 3-6.



From 69/59 S:

- Exit 127A onto Main St.
- Turn Right on Fannin St.
- Left on Southmore Blvd.
- Left on San Jacinto St.
- Parking Garage entrance is on the left off of San Jacinto.
- Parking is available on levels 3-6.



From 288 South:

- Exit Southmore Blvd / Blodgett St
- Left on Southmore Blvd.
- Right on San Jacinto St.
- Parking Garage entrance is on the left off of San Jacinto.
- Parking is available on levels 3-6.



From the Medical Center:

- Head North on Main Street
- Take the first exit around the fountain to Hermann Drive
- Left on San Jacinto St.
- Parking Garage entrance is on the left off of San Jacinto.
- Parking is available on levels 3-6.
