Respect and Dignity

- **Treat Others with Respect**: Show consideration and courtesy to all patients, visitors, and staff members. Harassment, discrimination, or abusive behavior of any kind will not be tolerated.
- **Privacy**: Respect the privacy and confidentiality of all patients. Avoid discussing patient information in public areas.

Safety and Security

- **Follow Facility Policies**: Adhere to all posted signs and facility policies, including those related to smoking, use of electronic devices, and restricted areas.
- **Personal Belongings**: Keep personal belongings with you at all times. The facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
