DUTY TO WARN/PATIENT REJECTION AND WAIVER FORM

There are many factors that determine which eyeglass lens material is best for you, your lifestyle and how you use your glasses. Selecting the proper material for your eyewear is critical. Not only do lens materials affect the quality of your vision, but the material of your lenses also has a significant impact on the safety of your eyes! If your occupation or hobbies subject you to flying objects or physical impact, then an impact resistant material should be used. In our office, we strongly recommend the use of impact resistant lenses simply because your safety, vision and the health of your eyes is our main concern.

<u>Eyeglass lenses made from glass or CR-39 (basic plastic) are not impact resistant.</u> In the event of an accident, lenses made from these materials can shatter, resulting in vision loss and/or blindness.

I understand that my doctor has prescribed Trivex® or polycarbonate lenses for my visual safety and protection. I hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily, and with full knowledge of the risks and possible consequences, decided to utilize an alternative material for eyewear.
